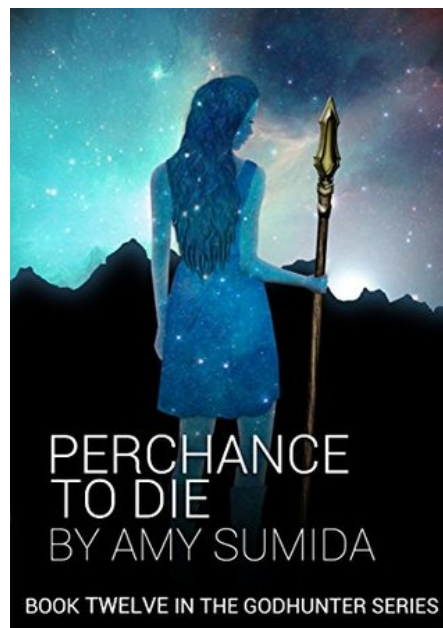




Perchance To Die
