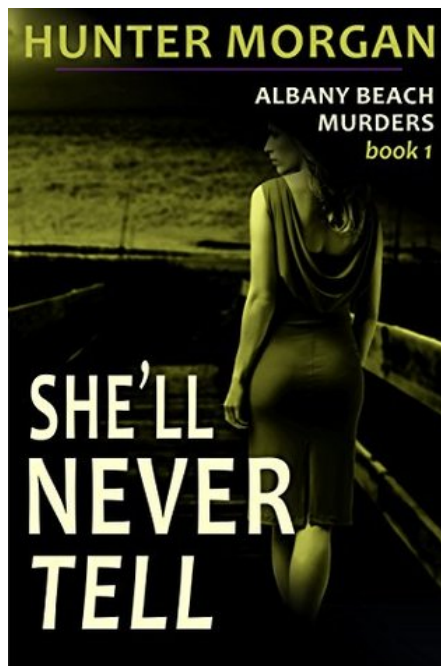




She'll Never Tell (The Albany Beach Murders, Book 1): Romance Psychological Suspense

If you are a fat girl like Marcy you always think things would be perfect if you could just be thin and beautiful. It was even worse for Marcy because her twin sister Phoebe is thin and beautiful. Then after a horrific car wreck that leaves Marcy in a coma for 6 months, her dream comes true. Now her life will be perfect. But is it? Marcy lives in Albany Beach, Delaware (take note Literary Escapes Challenge members because Delaware is a difficult state to find) where a serial killer of blue eyed blondes is loose. I really liked this book. In fact I loved it. The characters were well developed and likable. There was enough suspense to keep me reading and keep my heart pounding. So why did I not give it 5 stars? It is not a stand-alone novel, at least not if you really want to know who dunnit. The killer is still on the loose at the end of the book. Luckily I was able to check out book 2, *She'll Never Know*, from my local library so I can immediately continue the story.

In *She'll Never Tell* the small beach town of Albany Beach, Delaware has its first murder in over fifty years. A local waitress and party girl is found beside a dumpster in the park; she is dead and has been bleed out at another location.

Marcy Edmond a local mother of two in a happy marriage has been a coma since her new mini van ran off the road in late fall. She wakes up in the hospital after six months and she is in for a shock. Her face was rebuilt by plastic surgeons to look like her beautiful twin sister and she has dropped over sixty pounds.

Her twin sister, Phoebe is living with her family and has taken over the roll as the mother. Marcy has some issues to get straight in her head to get her life back together. She realizes that life is too short to not make the most of all the happy times and work for what she wants from life.

She also has some hard truths to face when it comes to her sister. She also has a creepy feeling like someone is watching her at odd times in town and when she is home alone or out jogging. A second murder of a tourist adds to the tension in the small town.

All this time a man the author refers to as the 'Bloodsucker' is watching the ugly duckling sister that has turned into a swan.

The romance between Jake and Marcy has a difficult time as they each learn to appreciate each other and their family again. The unsolved serial killer is still tracking his next victim as the Chief of Police, Claire works hard to find him, as he hides in plain sight.

This was generally a well-written, interesting and suspenseful book, I particularly liked the main characters who were well-defined, fleshed-out and believable, although some of the minor characters were a bit sketchy and because of this their motives for some of their actions was unclear. The plot was clever and quite original with two parallel story lines, and I liked that the psychological effects of beauty and intelligence were explored. There were some silly errors in the text, confusing carbon monoxide with carbon dioxide for example. However I am afraid that it ended with one of my biggest bug-bears about books, a 'hanging' ending, so although there was 'happy for now' ending to this story, the murderer is not identified or caught and apparently the other 2 books in the trilogy need to be read to find out who it is, this is unforgivable to me, and based purely on that fact I am really glad that I didn't pay for it as I received a copy of this book from e-book discovery.
