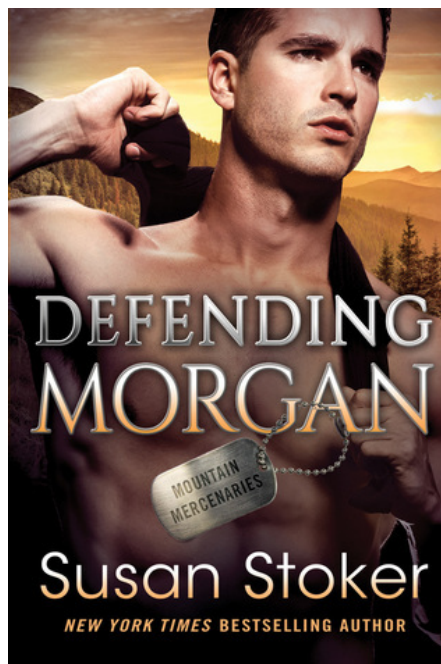




Defending Morgan
