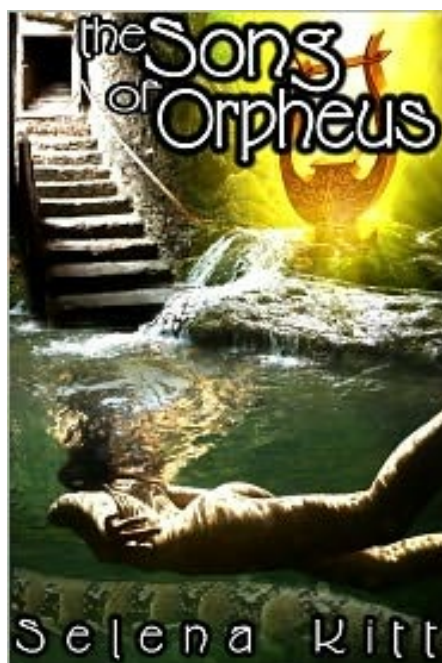




The Song of Orpheus
