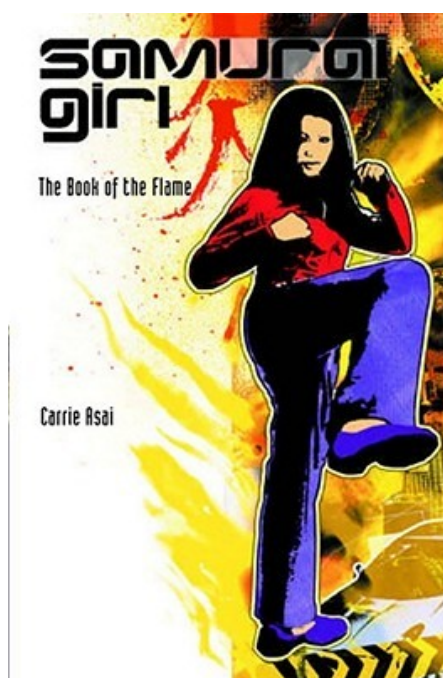




The Book of the Flame

After all, her ex-fience Teddy is part of that same family, and she may be entertaining feelings for him. This is yet ANOTHER relationship roller-coaster, since she leads him on/uses him when it suits her, then turns him in or gets him shot, and yet he still claims to love her! The biggest dissapointment is the re-appearance of Heaven's friend Cheryl who was seriously scarred by the house-fire that made Heaven run away to Vegas, but not killed. At first this is a relief, since she seemed to be the one level-headed friend she had on her side since the beginning, but then it's found out she's been persuaded by Heaven's enemies (& possibly ex-girlfriend Karen to destroy Hiro.) to take revenge and she is also hooked on crack to dull the physical and mental pain in her life. Bitterness/anger + drugs + yakuza gangsters = one messy sceniero! In the end Heaven is finally tired of running and gets arrested. She is actually grateful to tell the police everything and they have her uncle Masato come to pick her up and offer to take her back to Japan. You can tell at this point that series is coming to a head, but it's frustrating that still nobody knows the identity of the masked ninga(s) who killed Heaven's brother and put her father in a coma...
