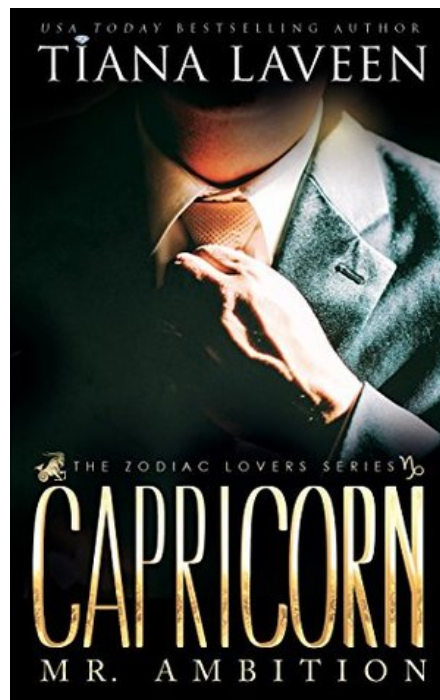




Capricorn - Mr. Ambition: The 12 Signs of Love
