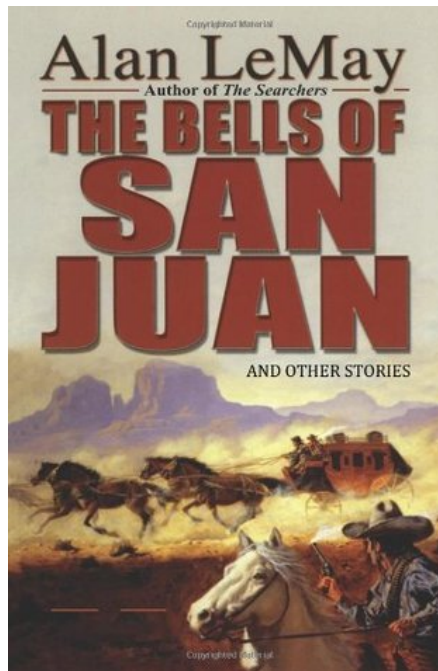

Among the selections is "The Little Kid," perhaps LeMay's most touching story, a poignant tale of a young boy who is orphaned when his father is killed on a cattle drive. Few writers could match LeMay's skill in evoking the full range of emotion in his characters—wonderful, living people who fill the pages of this collection with the heart and spirit of the Old West.
