The main "theme" of the book is to teach children how important books are and how fun they can be. Now this is a good idea but my family already knows about books and how great they are, so my family didn't care for the story compared to the other books in the series but we did get a few good laughs from the silliness of the characters.

Pictures:

I'm not to sure what to say here but to say that the pictures are very colorful and bright like most children books. Some of the characters in the story are animals, which little ones in my family love to point and if you're child likes this sort of set up then your child should enjoy the book. I know this from experience because this book did keep the youngest in my family entertain just from looking at the pictures.

Education:

There is not much to say for education. The "moral" of the story is to teach children how great books are but I feel like most parents out there are pushing their children to read more especially schools. Now a days schools are sending children home with more reading assignments compared to what I had to do when I went to grade school. Now if you want to get this book for your child to practice reading then I should point out that if your child is already reading for school then they may not want to read just for fun. I have an 8 year old little cousin who I asked if she wanted to try to read this book and she replied that she didn't want to read it because she didn't want to do more "homework" and preferred me to read it to her, and so I read the book to both an 8 year old girl and a 7 year old boy. Now for her, she didn't care for the book but she is very advance for her age and wants to do more "grown up things" but the 7 yr old boy had a lot of fun with it and enjoyed the book a lot. So I would say the best "education" that this book has is the fact a child can practice reading through it. Also the reason I am not giving any names out for the children in my family is because I'm posting this online, and I prefer to be anonymous.

Binding:

Binding wise, this book is flimsy. It is not a hardcover and the pages are thin, but not as thin compared to other books. So for older children, like 5-6yr olds, this book should be fine in their hands without supervision but for younger children you should keep an eye on them so no accidents occur. A good note about the book being thin is the fact that it won't take up to much space on a bookshelf which we are running out of space all the time. Our poor bookshelf has been overstuff for years, but somehow we are always managing to put one more book on each time.
