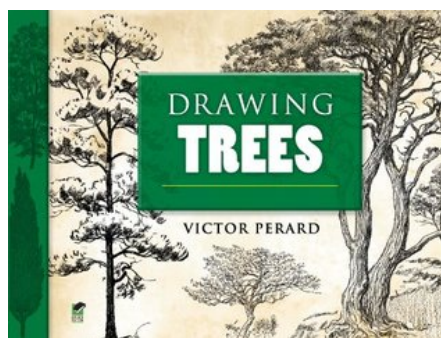




Drawing Trees (Dover Art Instruction)
