From the very beginning you are thrust into a world of intuition where a sisterly bond seems a little uncanny, let alone the ability to calm a man's testosterone driven emotions. Combine that with Marvel X-men related splicing of DNA and you've got one testy wolf-man. Although there is no shape shifting involved, Collin

McBain is faster, stronger and Payton finds him sexier than other men around her, but really can't stand him.

All that changes when they are thrust into a fifth wheel together as Payton takes her beloved dobermans to showcase in the region. The hot sex between Payton and Collin is a natural progression between the two as they discover their powers are growing in ways neither of them had thought possible.
