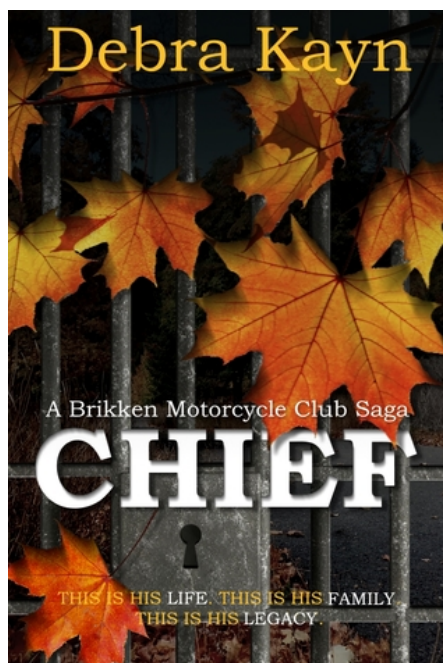

I am a little late to the party. This is Debra Kayn's 50th Novel and my first time reading her. I have to say I wish I would have known about her before. Her writing style reminded me of *Fearless by Lauren Gilley* -the cheating.

This book follows Bug from age 8 to age 29 and Chief age 34 to 55 - there was a 26 year age gap. *They were never "together" when she was under age.*
