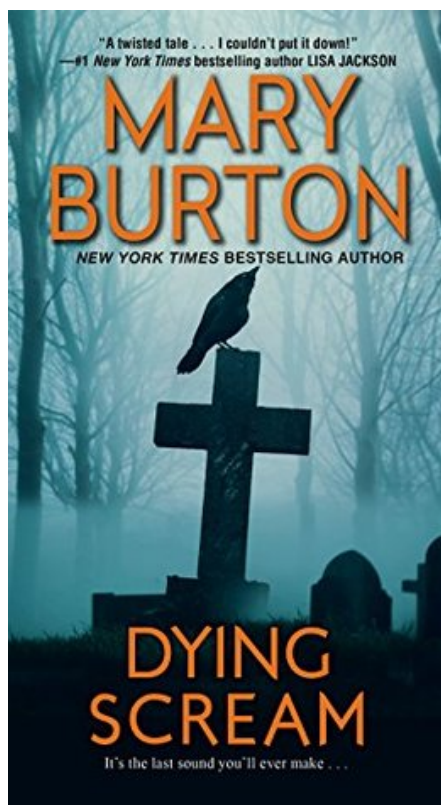




Dying Scream
