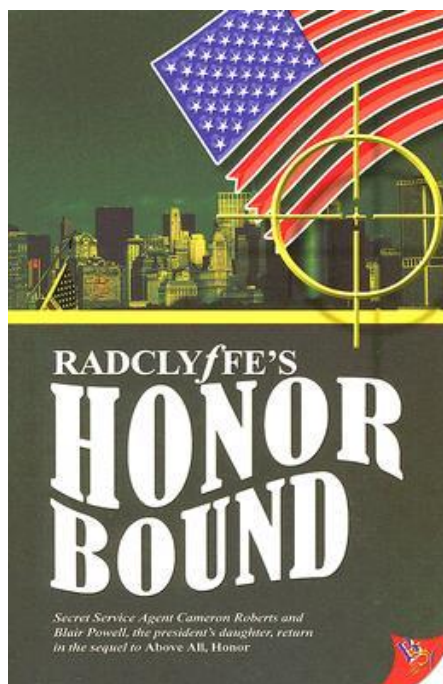

With Cameron and Blair separated by job and country their newly realized relationship is in a holding pattern. Cameron has been reassigned back to the Investigative Unit and Blair is on an official trip to China with her father, the President of the United States. But things change quickly as Cam is ordered to immediately return to her position as Commander of the security detail in charge of "Egret", she is not told why but she rushes back just as Blair is back from China. As Cam enters the command center she is very grateful to Mac for keeping things under control and Mac is glad to have her back, but the problem is that Blair is totally unaware that Cam has been reassigned and doesn't know why since she sent Cam away after the shooting left her critically injured. As the two try to understand each other, both professionally and personally, they also have to deal with the ever increasing stalker with only partial information thanks in part to politics. Blair doesn't want Cam there because she doesn't want to see her hurt and Cam needs to be there to make sure Blair isn't hurt. Meanwhile they slowly acknowledging their feelings for each other while trying to keep it in the dark and muddle through all the bureaucratic red tape. "Loverboy" keeps escalating his actions to be with Blair, first it was the packages, then the mail, then emails, and then a bombing that claims one of the officers trying to protect Blair.

Blair Powell is a more than an interesting woman caught in a multi-layered conundrum being related to such a public figure. Plus, with her mother having succumbed to breast cancer when she was nine years old, she performs double duty which also includes being an escort to her esteemed father. She has a beautiful mind of her own, a blistering passion for the person who captured her love, and a distinct sense of independence that puts the secret service team assigned to her on their toes nearly always. I simply cherish Blair and more than admire her heart, spirit, and often cantankerous nature brought on by her almost exclusively living in a fishbowl and often under the microscope of practically everyone. What a spitfire!

Cameron Roberts to me appears as if she were born to be a United States secret service agent and the formidable head of the team responsible for the Blairs' safety twenty-four hours of every day. She can adjust her demeanor within the scope of her role in a form I have yet to observe in anyone. Additionally she can function on next to no sleep for days at a time. However, her most endearing quality to me was when she knows how fervid her feelings are for Blair, she openly reveals the depth of her affection yet manages to balance and execute the times of her expressions of this intent in a well-nigh perfectly covert manner. She may be the most consummate professional I have ever had the pleasure of reading about.
