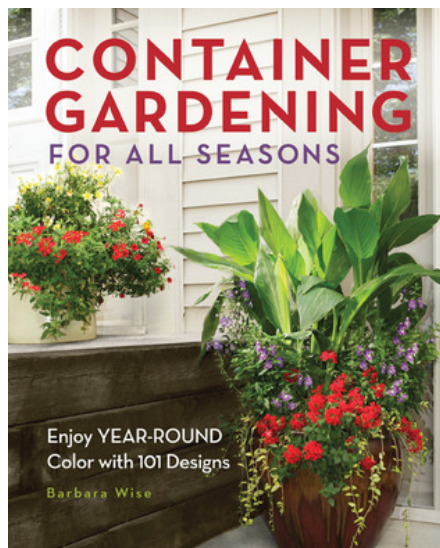




Container Gardening for All Seasons: Enjoy Year-Round Color with 101 Designs
