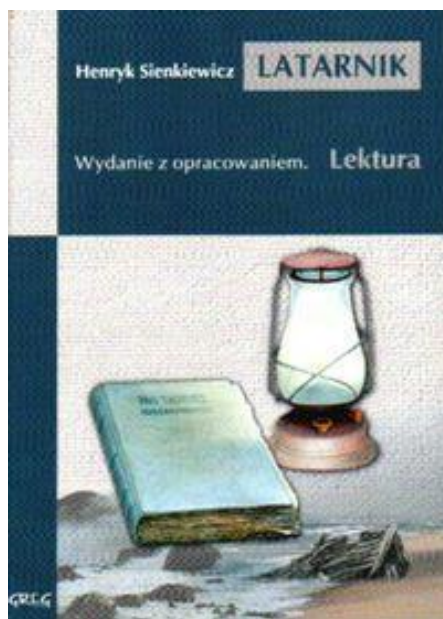




Latarnik
