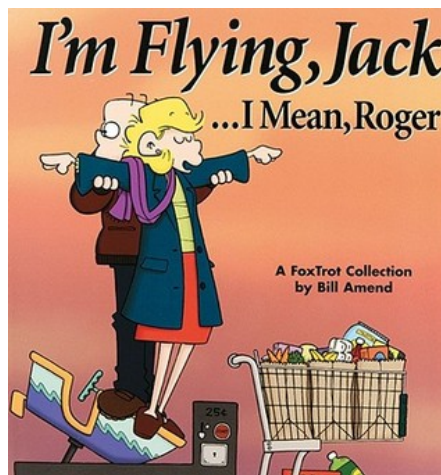




I'm Flying, Jack...I Mean, Roger: A FoxTrot Collection
