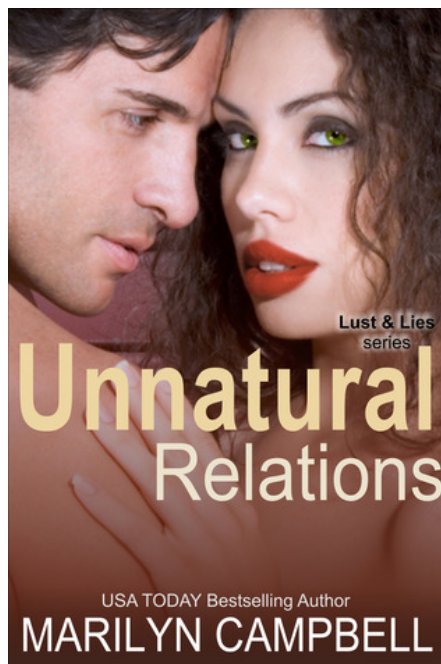




Unnatural Relations

Matthew's grandparents, who didn't know about him have also found them, and they want Matthew. Barbara Mancuso was a young aspiring actress when she met and fell in love with Howard Hamilton, heir to a huge fortune. They planned to marry but Howard's parents did not approve. Howard disappeared from her life with only the lawyers words that he had gone to Europe with his mother and dissolving the engagement. Russ was a childhood friend of Howards whose father was the gardener. He befriended Barbara especially when she found out she was pregnant. He moved in with her and then went psycho trying to own her, finally beating her up and causing her to go into labor. She got away from him and was in hiding ever since.
