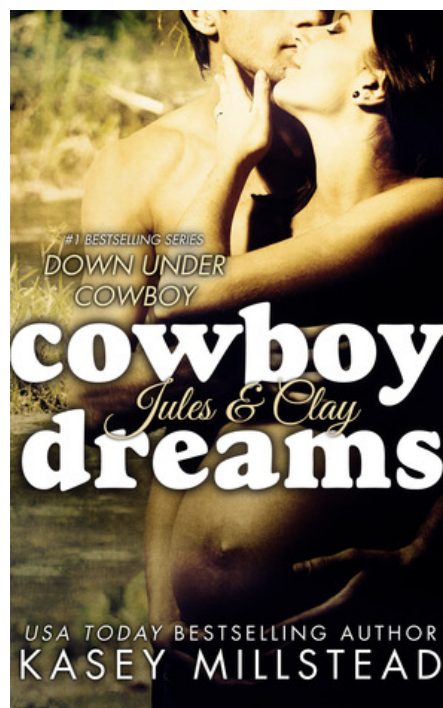




Cowboy Dreams
