There are often some feels in the Harlequin Desire books, whether they're small or medium. But this one? Oh my goodness, did it throw the feels at me! I mean, almost right from the start I just knew it would continue to be heavy, and I wasn't wrong. While it was full of feels, it was also full of heart, love, and sweet moments.

Ellie and her brother, Kirby, are back in town to help care for their grandpa temporarily. Their family had left when they were younger to go to South America. Now that they were back, Ellie asks to Conor if he could do a favor for her. Kirby had an accident that caused him to lose his foot. This same accident killed Ellie's husband--right before she found out she was pregnant with his child. (Can you see what I mean about being heavy on the feels?!) Ellie and Conor spend time together, and the desire they felt before is still there. Unfortunately, there are new things blocking their path--with everything Ellie has been through in recent times, she hasn't come to terms with it fully. And Conor hasn't completely changed--he still wants to push the limits. Will their feelings help them find a way?

Very good reunion story. After a devastating accident that ended Conor's dreams of competition he set his eyes on different challenges. One of them is being part of the family business and making his ski resort one of the best. When he hears that his childhood friends, Ellie and Kirby Porter are back in town he's happy, but also wary. His teenage crush on Ellie had ended badly when she wanted him to choose between his risky activities and her, so he's surprised when she comes to him for help.

Ellie and her brother have come back to Silver Glen to take care of their sick grandfather. Ellie is also at her wit's end trying to figure out how to help her brother, who was badly injured in the same climbing accident that killed her husband. She thinks that Conor, having had to overcome his own disappointments, is just the person to help his old friend. She doesn't count on her old feelings for him coming back too.

Conor agrees to spend time with Kirby, and soon it is as if they had never been apart. I loved their first meeting, as Conor faced the elephant in the room and commented on Kirby's artificial foot. After the initial shock, Kirby reacted with the humor that Conor remembered from their youth. I loved seeing Kirby come out of the depression he was in and begin to live again.

Spending time with Kirby also meant spending time with Ellie. The attraction they felt as teens is much stronger now, but there are still obstacles blocking their path. Between her husband's death, having her baby and taking care of Kirby and her grandfather, Ellie has avoided dealing with any of the emotions that came with them. Avoiding her attraction to Conor is out of the question, and a fling with him may be just what she needs. Conor can't stay away from Ellie, but he also doesn't want to take advantage of her while she is vulnerable. He can see that she's living on the edge and he doesn't want to hurt her.

I loved how much Conor obviously cared for Ellie. He tries so hard to do the right thing, but she is determined to have her way. The heat between them is intense and opens the door to more than just sex. I loved seeing them grow closer, and especially the way that Conor's protectiveness came out when Ellie was hurt. But he is keeping a big secret from her that may end anything before it really has a chance to get going. And her reluctance to talk about her late husband has him wondering if he's just a stand in. At the same time, Ellie's own past has her believing that Conor wouldn't want her if he knew the truth.

Another devastating blow to Ellie and Kirby brings everything out into the open, where both Conor and Ellie have to deal with it. It is here where Conor's feelings for Ellie really shine through and bring them the happiness they both deserve.

As a secondary character, I really loved Kirby. It would be great to see him get his own story.

This second chance story took me by surprise. There's more to it, than I expected.

Connor is enthralled with the idea of his childhood friends being back in town, even though Ellie once broke his heart. But things are not as expected. Life has been rough for the twins, Ellie had lost her husband, is a single mother, and nearly lost her twin Kirby, as well. Kirby's left leg is partly amputated, and now their grandfather has fallen ill, needing help.

So much agony, sorrow, and pain in the twins' life for the past 18 months. Connor is doing what he can to help, and as it seems to help Kirby, to be around Connor again, Ellie seems to be falling in pieces.

Connor is an honorable, gentle, loving man. His own disappointments in life have guided to be in the place in life where he is, in a solid place, where he is content.

Ellie understandably has it tough, so much drama in her life in the past couple years. She goes boldly after what she wants, and that is intimacy with Connor, and help with her brother. I wasn't sure if I should have rooted for her resolute to go after Conner, again and again. At times her behavior seemed audacious, but maybe it was just a misplaced call for help. She also reacts rather strongly with things happening, she seems to be a bit of a drama queen. But there is a reason for her emotional behavior, if she could only open up about it, and share her pain.

Like said, there's much more to the story than I expected. I enjoyed it, it had some original twists in the story. It also had lots of angst and pain, bereavement and sorrow. All the dark emotions nearly over powered the joy of the baby, the treasure of reunited childhood friends, and the passion, wonder and glee of the new relationship between Connor and Ellie
