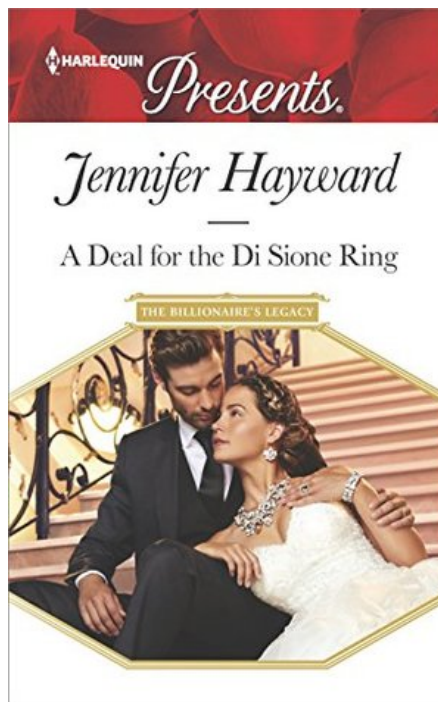




A Deal for the Di Sione Ring

Disjointed, episodic marriage of convenience story that never really jelled. The hero is a half brother to all the other DiSione's taking part in the ~~Horcrux~~ hunt "lost mistresses" search for their grandfather. The heroine has the ring the hero wants, but must she must be married for one year before she can sell it. The hero rescues her from a violent groom minutes before the wedding and marries her for the ring.

It's a great premise, but the characterization of both the H/h was inconsistent and threads were dropped all over the place.

How inconsistent?

Hero:

At the opening, the hero is an obnoxious pig when he hits on the chambermaid heroine, teasing her when he knows she can't fight back.

Then he turns into New Age man when he explains to the heroine that she has PTSD from being hit by her fiancé and that she needs to learn martial arts to feel empowered.

He says he's going to teach her the hotel business, he's going to make her a gladiator. (view spoiler)

The heroine's arc is even worse:

At the opening, she is a secret chambermaid to earn money for her ungrateful mother.

She agrees to marry an abusive Sicilian mob boss so her mother can live in comfort.

The abusive mob boss is supposed to be all powerful, but he does nothing to her family after she jilts him at the altar.

There is no follow up as to how her mother's debts are settled.

The heroine went to finishing school so she is comfortable at parties and puts everyone at ease with her charm.

But she is naive and virginal and is in danger from predatory men.

The heroine, after one week, is giving a marketing presentation to a group of executives.

The heroine is jealous of an OW in Hong Kong, which goes exactly nowhere because they move on to the Maldives.

The heroine wants to be a career woman.

The heroine wants the picket fence and children.

The heroine wants to fight for the hero's love until (view spoiler)

I could go on and on. No issue was explored in depth, partly because the author moved them from Sicily to Corsica to Hong Kong to the Maldives to New York City to Paris.

This was a contradictory hot mess.

On page 113 I lost interest in the romance because there was no romance building. Yes the hero & heroine were married but he pushed the heroine away and the heroine began focusing on her career. I'm reading this for the romance and it ain't happening by now. Unfortunate because the potential for the romance began when the heroine and hero first met but the focus quickly shifted away from it.

As a HP reader I expect the romance building to be central in the storytelling along with the hero being ruthless & possessive towards the heroine. It didn't happen in this book so I did not finish it.

Her daughter is her ticket to wealth, no more debt and a life of leisure. Unfortunately Mina doesn't want to marry and especially the not so nice Silvio. Her hope is to sell are ring she inherits once she marries and pay off her mothers debt.

Giovanni, Nate Di Sione's grandfather is dying and asks Nate for a favor. Their is a ring that he would like in his possession again before he dies. He asks Nate to please track it down and return it to him. Nate can't refuse his grandfathers dying wish. He does some investigating and finds that it's in Italy, and belongs to the Mastrantino family, Mina Mastrantino.

Nate arrives in Italy and meets with Mina. But he also learns of her unfortunate dilemma, marriage to a cruel Silvio. Nate decides he has a solution for both their situations, marriage (Mina can only give the ring away after she's married).

I found this to be a little to far fetched, even for an HP romance. Mina and her actions came across unbelievable, her reactions at times childish and I found her to be a weak character and heroine. The Mother daughter relationships was too way out there and to not have Mina stand up to her Mother or come up with a solution for herself was hard to swallow. The scene with her at home preparing to leave for her wedding and Nate show up at that exact moment seemed ridiculous to me (the set up and her inter dialogue, was..... *eye roll*),.

We then have Nate and Mina back in the states with Nate offering to help her live life and teach/train her for the business world. Again, Mina and Nate's interaction and how that unfolds seemed forced and choppy as well.

The story line didn't work for me. The heroine was weak and average.
