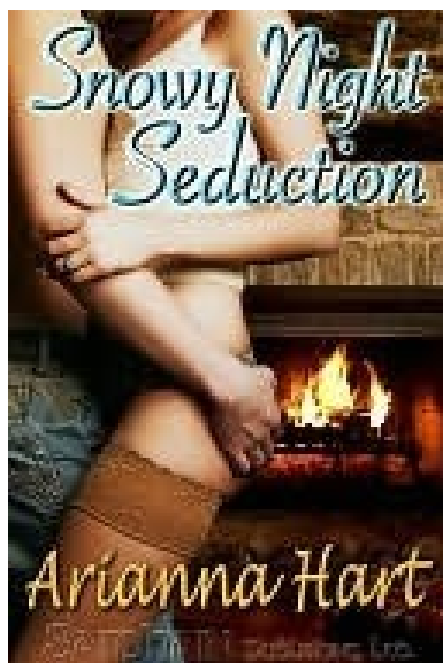




Snowy Night Seduction
