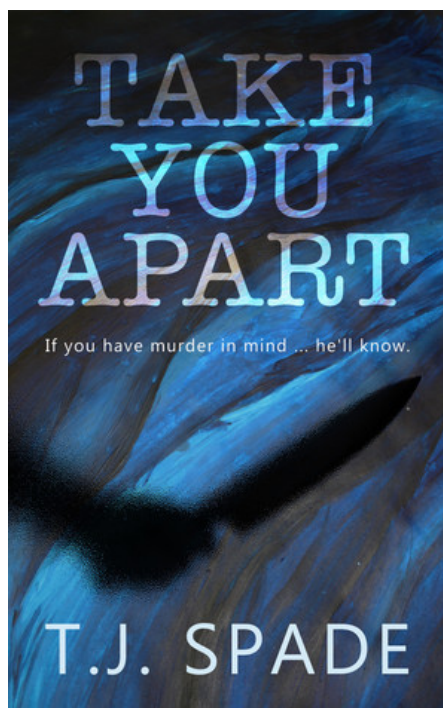




Take You Apart

To say that this was a psychological thriller would leave the description wanting. It was far more than that. It carried such depth to the characters and expressed their emotional turmoil with such ease that, as a reader, I was swept up in the tidal wave of intrigue, fear and at times, devastation that TJ Spade created in this story.

Caleb Everett did not have an easy childhood. Some might say he came from an abusive family but I believe he was misunderstood by his father, who didn't know how to accept Caleb's psychic gifts.

After losing his parents tragically as a young boy, his upbringing with his surrogate family, The Scotts, had given him the care and understanding that he needed. Ethan Scott became his brother and their relationship could not have been stronger. Ethan becoming Caleb's guide through his tricky times.

Through a series of encounters with Detective Jack Rafferty, Caleb finds a niche for his psychic abilities and sets about assisting the detective with their murder cases. I was asked to review by T.J. Spade and I'm so glad I did.

Wow, what a debut novel and the start of a series that I will be definitely be continuing with. The story starts with eleven-year-old Caleb and his rough start in life at the hands of his abusive father, who thinks Caleb is evil due to a gift that the young boy possesses.

We then skip twenty years and Caleb is a full grown (and may I add 'hot') adult who now uses his gift to help the homicide unit of the police department led by his friend Detective Jack Rafferty, who he met on the detective's first homicide case and the pair have been solving murders together since. A new case soon becomes personal for Caleb as people close to him are being targeted and he is soon drawn into a game of cat and mouse.

Caleb must learn how to control his gift in a race against time to find the killer before it is too late for his new love interest Mikayla, who enters his life looking for her next big story as a journalist and gets placed right in the middle of the game that Caleb is being drawn into.
