Hunter, none too happy, proceeds to hurt Emily's feelings and it is known throughout town that he was forced to ask her to go even though they were sort of friends. When Emily returns to town, Hunter then faces reality that she is indeed his mate. But Emily just wants to steer clear of him and hasn't forgotten his betrayal.
