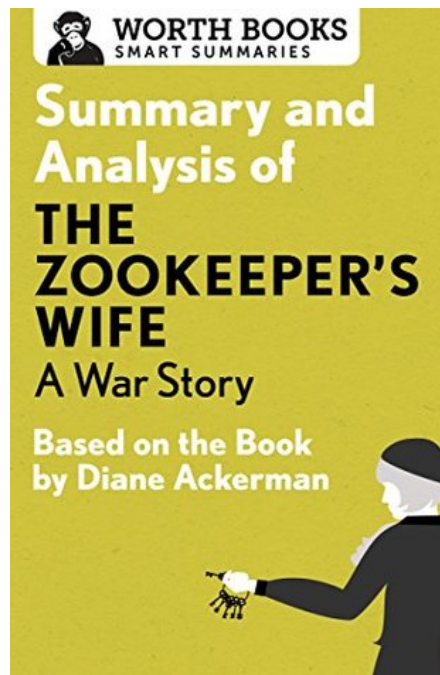




Summary and Analysis of The Zookeeper's Wife: A War Story: Based on the Book by Diane Ackerman (Smart Summaries)
