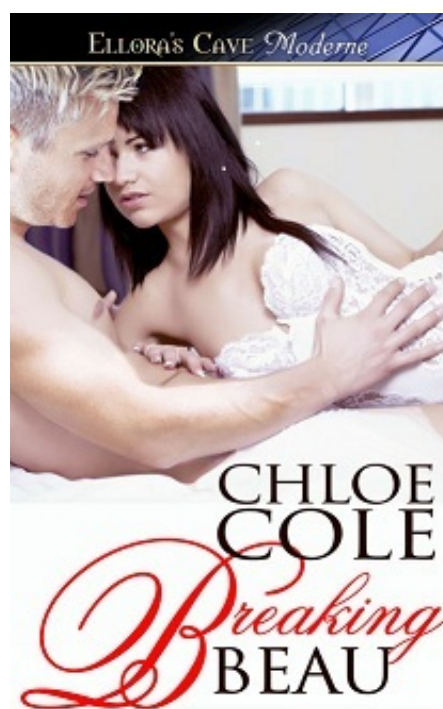




Breaking Beau

This was a very good story. I met Beau in book #1 Convincing Quinn and he proved to be a good guy in that story so I was anxious to see him get his own HEA. Gigi is great for Beau and their story is short but very sweet. :D

Gigi is a chef and working hard to get her own business off the ground. She's hoping the money and references she'll get from catering a few weeks on tour for the band Hank Lemon and the Law will help accomplish that. She's been working hard since her father died when she was 13 years old. Working nights and going to school during the day to help her family get by. She's never had time for a social life and has never even kissed a guy. She certainly never expected to find herself attracted to one of the members of the band.

Beau is the fiddle player for the band, Hank Lemon and the Law. He loves music and has been playing since he was a kid. He's never had a girlfriend in his life, the closest he came was thinking that he was in love with Quinn (the singer of the band) but realized he didn't in time to help her and his other band mate, Rex get together. They're married now and Beau's happy for them but wishes for something like their relationship for himself. When he meets Gigi, he doesn't expect to want her as she's so far from his normal type, yet he can't seem to stop his eyes from following her.

As the band is coming back from a break, the tour bus that has already picked up Beau stops to pick up Gigi, giving them a night alone before picking up the rest of the band the next day. Gigi makes dinner for the 2 of them and they talk. She ends up telling him about her past and her dreams for her future business and he realizes she's exactly the type of woman his mother would want for him. He plays her some beautifully done violin music and it touches her. They make a connection through the night and Beau asks to kiss her. At this point Gigi admits her severe lack of experience and Beau gives her a wonderfully hot first kiss. Things get interrupted and go no further. When they meet up with the rest of the band, Quinn (playing matchmaker) dolls Gigi up in a nice dress and tickets to the show. Beau is feeling more and more interest in Gigi (although he had still liked her in her old cloths) so he isn't happy when she propositions him for 1 night and nothing more.

At this point things get a little screwy and Tai-Nan (the bass player) ends up in the mix but proves he's a good guy and helps Beau out. Beau and Gigi end up having a wonderful (and hot) night. One that changes

things for Gigi and when she wakes up (Beau being in the shower), she freaks because her future plans don't seem so great compared to being with Beau but she doesn't believe Beau really wants her. She runs and it causes some mis-understandings and hurt feelings. Fortunately, Tai-Nan steps in with some wise advice and Gigi decides she has to talk to Beau. She tracks all around town and eventually finds him. They talk things out and decide they're going to have a serious relationship and work on staying together. No I love you's are exchanged, too soon for that, but they have a good start to a HEA.

This was a very enjoyable read. It was short but packed with feeling and very sweet (and hot!). I loved the connection between Beau and Gig and was happy them work things out. I'll be reading book #3, Tai-Nan's book. He was great in this one so I'd like to see how his turns out. I'd recommend this book.

The idea of still playing the same games he did with Rex for the next several years wasn't something that Beau was really looking forward to, but since it seemed to be the only option at the moment it would have to do until something better came along. Having a chance to read an entire series in one sitting is something that I don't get to do all that often, but these characters were ones that I wanted to get to know better and when that opportunity presented itself I couldn't turn it down. I was hooked from the moment I started book one (Convincing Quinn) and had to know what happened in book two. I was completely invested in the characters and book two did not disappoint. It only made me love this author more.

Some series the stories seem to be disconnected or so connected you can't read just one, but Chloe Cole made this so that you could read it alone as a standalone book or as part of the series and still get the same great story.
