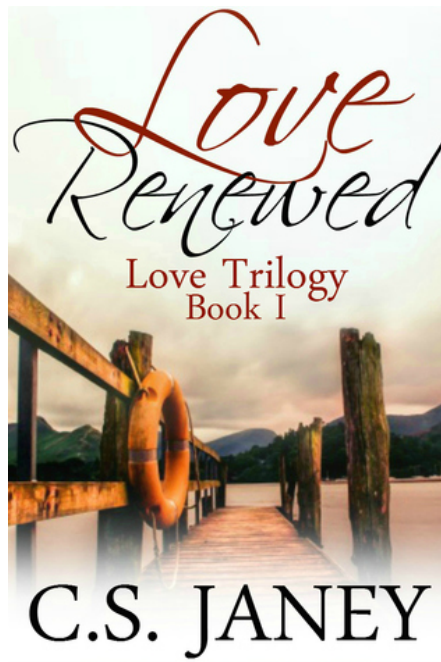




Love Renewed
