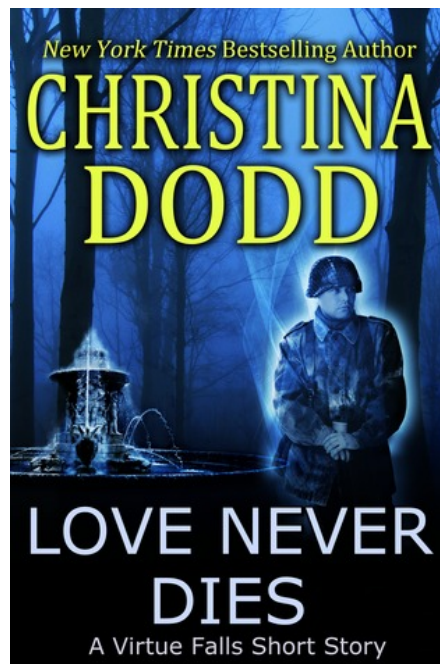

This short story by Christina Dodd in her Virtue Falls series, "LOVE NEVER DIES" introduces you to a young woman, new to the area, Areila.
