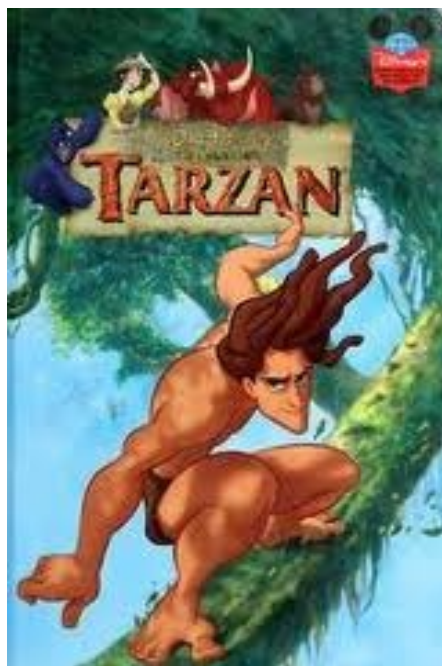




Tarzan

Tarzan is orphaned as a baby after his parents are killed by the leopard known as Sabor. Kala, a kind gorilla has just lost her own child to Sabor and discovers Tarzan after she hears him crying. Her mate, Kerchak is dead set against the child saying that it is not that their kind and that Kala must take him back to where she got him. She protests but wins the argument. At the same time, Kala's niece, Terk is quite taken by the baby and comes to love him like a cousin.

Tarzan grows into an adventurous young boy and gets himself into a lot of trouble with Kerchak and the other gorilla elders. He finds himself in big trouble when he tries to prove to Terk and her friends that he's not extra baggage and retrieves an elephant hair. The dangerous task almost gets him killed and the continuous disapproval of Kerchak. After questioning who he is, Kala reassures him that its not what he is on the outside but on the inside that counts and says that Kerchak just can't bring himself to see it.

Years pass and Tarzan grows into a man, still adored by his adoptive mother and cousin Terk, Tarzan finds himself in the middle something much bigger when he meets human for the first time. Over time, he begins to fall for Jane Porter and woman who is studying Gorillas with her father and a vile man named Clayton. He is invited to go back to England with them much to the distress of an jealous Terk and a worried Tantor, an Elephant friend of Terk and Tarzan's from childhood.

After it is discovered that Clayton is a traitor, Tarzan with the help of Jane, her father and his friends manage to put an end to Clayton's tyranny. Jane and her father stay in the jungle and Jane marries Tarzan.
