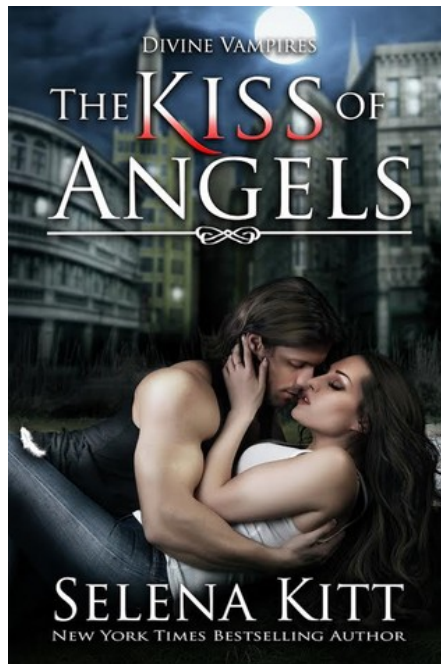




The Kiss of Angels

I'll start by saying I loved this story. The characters are interesting (a cupid and an angel of death), the premise is intriguing (first love and forbidden love), and the supporting cast help to move the plot along. The writing is classic Selena Kitt: crisp and to the point while still painting a vivid picture of the surroundings.

But this story, like most Kitt stories, goes one step further.

In every good book there's a line or scene that really resonates with you. It somehow manages to pin down (what you feel) is the theme, the very heart of the book. This is the line that did it for me: "That's it? ... That's all there is?"

I read that line several times. Given when and where it is said in the text, it's simply brilliant! And it made me rethink what I'd read to that point, and reframed how I considered the rest of the book. In 6 words, Ms. Kitt summed up life, love, and death, and took what could have been just another love story to the next level.

Should angels be falling in love? Especially two angels that are on two different levels and probably not allowed to mix by the "Maker"? These are questions that Ms. Kitt brings up in this very good read.

Muriel is a cupid, or love angel. She and her partner go about shooting love arrows at those couples that the "Maker" has chosen to fall in love. But Muriel has questions about the human condition and the feelings that her arrows cause to grow in the humans. She wonders about those feelings though she appears to be the only one that does. She meets Char, an angel of death, in a hospital room, that she has been sent to to send a love arrow essence of a seriously ill man. Char is there to take this very same person's essence and bring on his life to an end shortly after the love arrow pierces his essence. This begins a relationship between Muriel and Char as she tries to understand the reasons behind such decisions of the "Maker". Why a love arrow when death was so close?

Muriel and Char begin to spend time with each other even though they do not know if they should be associating with each other. Muriel's partner is concerned with the time she is spending with Char. As they spend time together the love between the two grow but Muriel still has questions about the human feelings and what they entail. After the death of a child Char comes up with a plan that will allow them to spend one day with each other as humans. What will be the cost of such adventure? Muriel and Char spend the 24 hour period with each other in passionate love making and the new sensations that are brought on by being in human form. They revel in happiness, but too soon the 24 hours are up.

What price do they pay? Is the "Maker" willing to forgive them? Will their love for each other die? What will Muriel have to do to continue to love and live with Char? A fascinating story and a quick read. Makes one wonder about the spirits around us.

With this installment of the Divine Vampires series, we get a little softer and a lot more emotional. If you've read *The Blood of Angels*, (book #1) then the end of this book will make complete sense. **However**, you do not have to read the first book for you to understand what's going on. Even though this book is part of a series it can most certainly be read independently.

Honestly, I don't really know how to review this without giving anything away. Have you ever walk into a room and can't remember why you went there in the first place? Maybe it was your Guardian Angel, a fairies compelling you to do it for a reason unbeknownst to you. Meet Muriel, a Cherub Angel (*aka Cupid*). She has always thought there was something else out there, but didn't know what. When she meets Chariel, a Seraphim, or Angel of Death, Muriel learns a little bit more about human emotions.

"Death is only sad because humans see it as the end," he said. "But we know it isn't."

Overall, I loved it. Story pacing, world building and very well written characters. There is sex but it does take a while to get to it. The relationship between Char and Muriel is so amazing, significant and beautiful. Then the connection from this book to the first book, *The Blood of Angels* is intricate. Just a fantastic read. This sequel tells the story of Char and Muriel who briefly appear in *The Blood of Angels* and explains their situation, which is a bit complex. Muriel is a Cherubim, like a cupid, and Char is a Seraphim - an angel of death - they meet and fall in love as angels but have no way to be together. Char works it so they can break some rules to be together for a day and he takes his punishment, leaving Muriel with no idea what happened to him. When she learns of his fate she'll do anything to share it with him.

Again, fairly unique working with the angels and the different classes. I was expecting more of this to deal with vampires, but that's only in the last 10% of the book (view spoiler). I admit, I was a bit creeped out at the way that Char and Muriel found to be together physically. They basically inhabited two people who'd just killed themselves and had sex together in borrowed bodies. A little bit ew. And I guess technically the characters were both virgins, even if the bodies they used weren't. The ending was delightfully angsty as Muriel gives it all up to be with Char, but once again, I found myself wanting a longer ending.

It is also worth mentioning again that we all know that Selena can certainly write terrifically naughty stories, as well as erotic short stories. I had already greatly enjoyed the first Divine Vampires book, and this one didn't disappoint. Most of the story takes place in the 40's, and tells the romance between Muriel, a cherubim, and Chariel, an angel of death. Both of them already appeared in the previous book, which happens later chronologically, and so their fate was already known. But, as for many stories, the journey there is more important.

The Kiss of Angels further expands the mythos of The Blood of Angels, and recaptures the sense of wonder Sam had for humanity through Muriel's interrogations on love. Feelings are more central here, as is mortality, Chariel being a seraphim whose task is to collect the soul of the dead. It's a more contemplative read, less joyful than Sam's story, but very satisfying. I sure hope hearing from Char and Muriel again!
