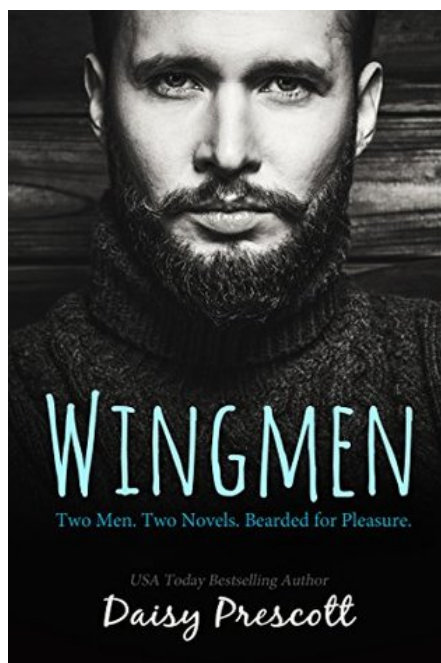




Wingmen
