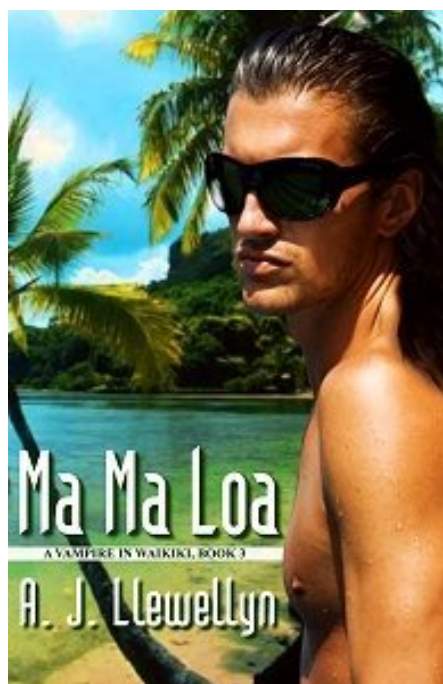




Ma Ma Loa
