I was first introduced to L.P. Dover with her Second Chances series. I fell in love with her style of writing and just couldn't get enough of it. While the Second Chances novels are more contemporary love stories, her Gloves Off series goes to the other extreme. They are also love stories but they are wrapped up in all sorts of alpha male hotness.

The Gloves Off series follows five different MMA fighters and the things they have gone through in life to get where they are. Each character has their own book that can be read as stand alone or as a series. I would recommend reading them as a series as there are characters that cross over from book to book.

The reading order for the series is: A Fighters Desire Part One & Part Two, Tyler's Undoing, Ryley's Revenge, Paxton's Promise and Camden's Redemption. There is also a novella called Winter's Kiss that brings us back to Ryley's story and then last but not least, Kyle's Return.

The characters are all wonderfully written and come to life right off of the page. In Camden's Redemption the story is told from the point of view of Camden and Brooklyn. They are two character's that have both had heartache and tragedy in their life and want to move on but don't know if they can.

Camden was introduced in the first book in the series A Fighter's Desire and the development of the character from then to now is amazing. It's like watching your kids grow up and knowing that you want to stop them from going through the hard times but at the same time having to let them learn to grow on their own from their mistakes. The question is how much is too much?
