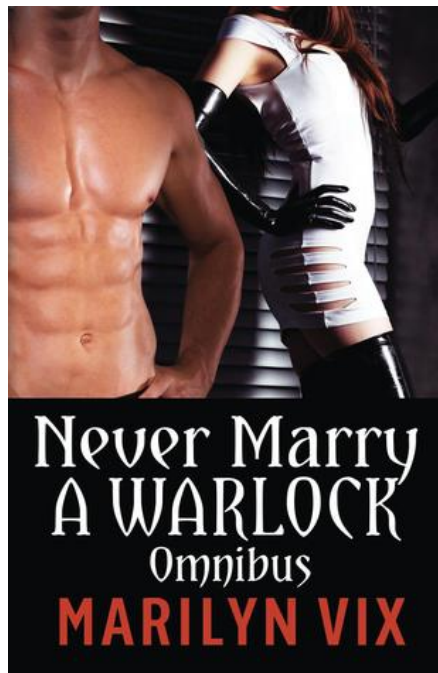




Never Marry a Warlock: Omnibus Edition
