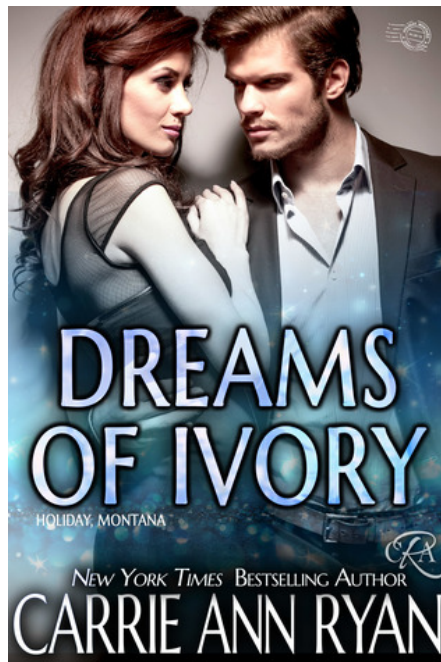




Dreams of Ivory
