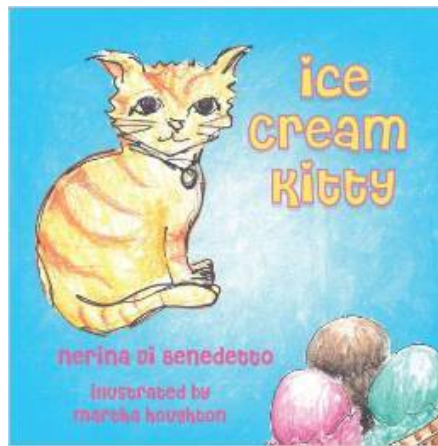




Ice Cream Kitty

The illustrations are good but not great. The text falls a bit flat.
