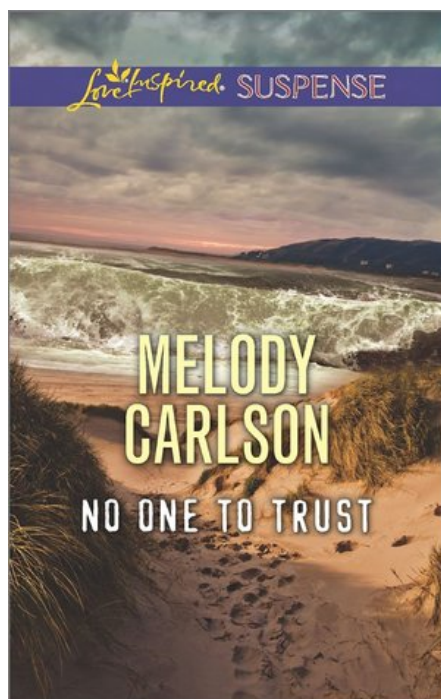




No One to Trust
