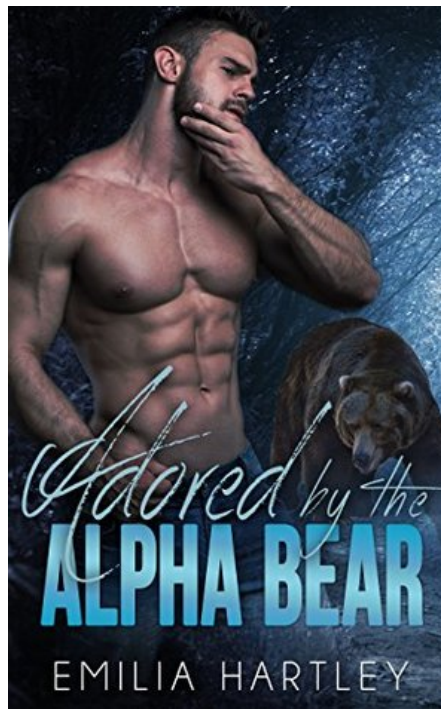




Adored by the Alpha Bear
