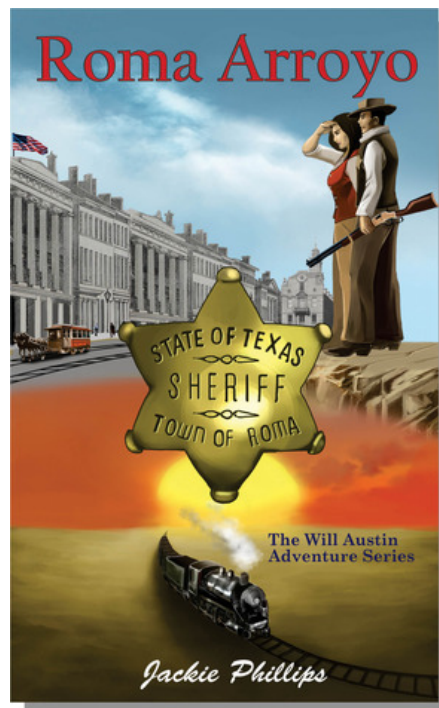

This book sets up the life of Will Austin, who hails from Boston, travelled to Texas to become a ranger and ended up as a sheriff in Roma, Texas. When we meet him, he has been shot and is the lone survivor at a camp in Mexico. Two children find him and bring him home to their ranch, where their mother Elizabeth patches him up.

As he recuperates, we learn his story and the story of how Elizabeth, a white woman, became the head of a large ranch in Mexico.

Of course, the two fall in love and we are left with the impression that any further Will Austin adventures will be as a married man.

It's a nice story and will keep you entertained for a few hours, but it did not change my mind or make me want long for the old cowboy days, which is what a good western story usually does for me.
