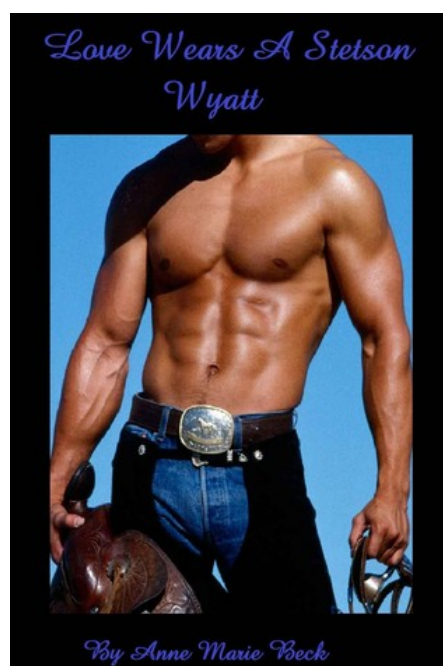




Love Wears A Stetson: Wyatt
