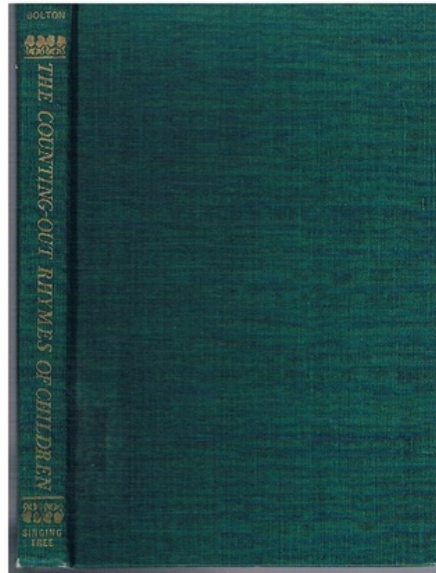




The Counting-Out Rhymes of Children: Their Antiquity, Origin, and Wide Distribution
