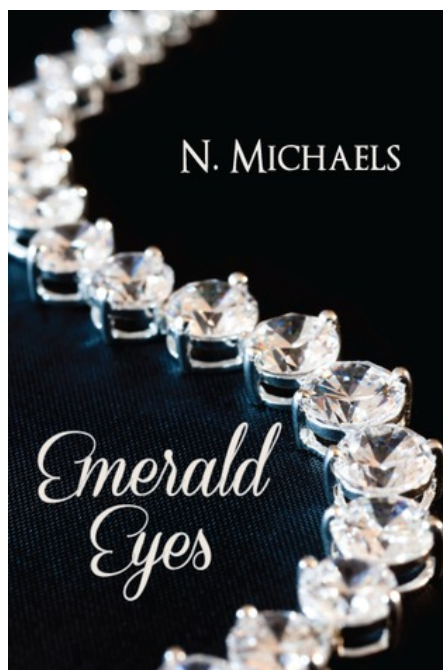




Emerald Eyes

Katherine opts for the latter, but manages to land on her feet quickly when she secures work as an Executive Assistant for the CEO of Miller Financial. She desperately needs the job in order to make ends meet, but she is quickly fascinated by her attractive boss; a boss who appears to be doing his best to resist her irresistible charm. Katherine and Eric attempt their best to settle into a professional relationship, but their instant physical chemistry is almost impossible to deny from the moment they meet and emotions run high whenever Mr. Miller requires Katherine's presence at after-hours functions.

"He lifts his head and notices me, but then his gaze falls on Patrick. His eyebrows furrow for a moment before he rises, then leans his head closer to mine.

"I didn't know you were going to bring a date," he whispers. The air escaping his mouth tickles my ear, sending goose bumps down the rest of my body.

Both Katherine and Eric have complicated personal lives, which lends more emotion to their growing sexual tension, and the result makes for an enjoyable read. Emerald Eyes is the debut novel from N. I would be remiss if I didn't mention the occasional technical glitches in the narrative, but none were severe enough to distract me from the overall enjoyment of the story. I've actually read two versions of Emerald Eyes within the last year and was quite pleased when I was just as caught up in my second read of the book as I was during the first. The characters in Emerald Eyes are well-developed and the story is well-paced. N. Michaels has done a great job of drawing the reader in to the emotions necessary to hold interest in the plot. There were moments of great tension – sexual and otherwise; and I always appreciate a good cliffhanger. Emerald Eyes ends on a startling note, and I'm looking forward to seeing what happens to Eric and Katherine in the upcoming sequel, Onyx Heart.

This is N. Michaels' debut book and it is a great, sexy, escapist romance. I had this book on my TBR list forever and is getting a re-release after being its original release in 2013. I could not put this book down once I started and it is a very good twist on the office romance theme.
