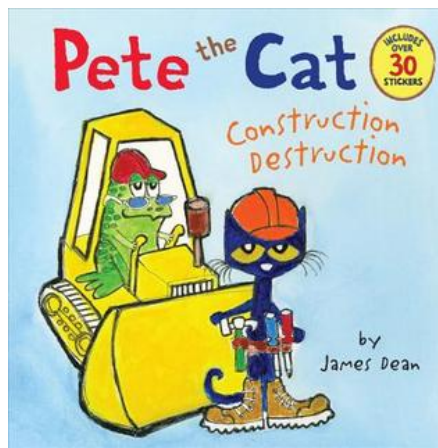

Pete makes a plan for a new playground then he asks the principal for permission to help build it. The next few days Pete hires a construction crew to help tear down the old one and build a new one. I love the text expressions made as Pete breaks up the old playground. "Clank! Clink" down goes the slide. "Bang! Boom! Down with the rusty tower. "HONK!" "HONK!" goes the recycling truck that collects the rusty metal. The illustrations are colorful and playful. The illustrations strongly interrelate with the text so that everything Pete does or says, it is illustrated to show readers what is happening. During our Community Helper's theme, students were introduced to this book because it helps children familiarize the concept of construction workers and what their work consists of.
