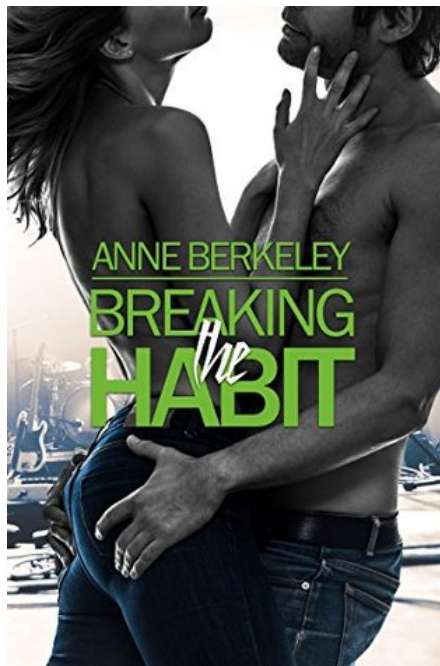




Breaking the Habit
