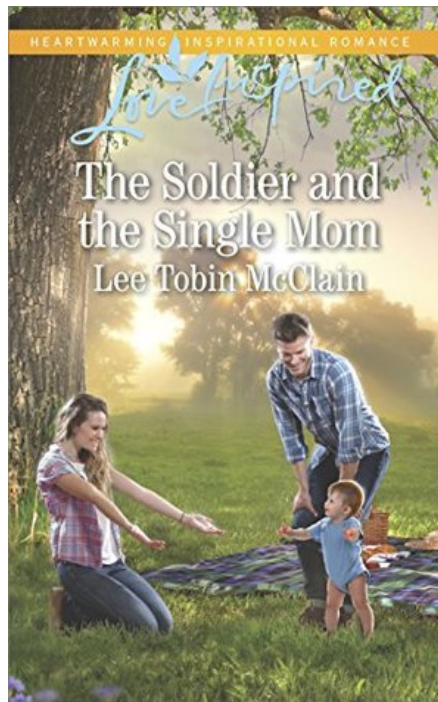




The Soldier and the Single Mom
