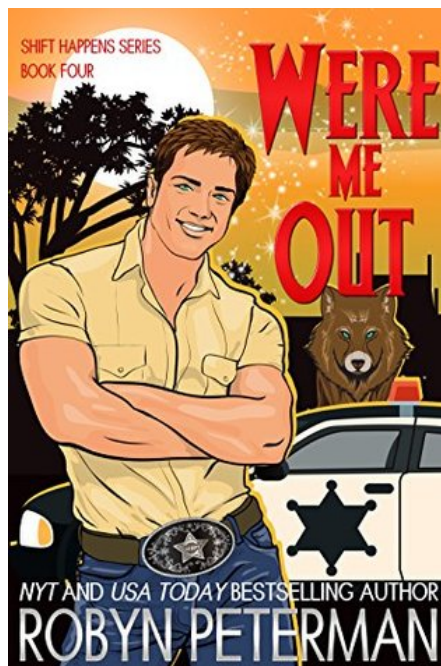




Were Me Out
