Evette is a woman who lives on her own terms in a way that so many others struggle to do. Though she has a serious illness, she refuses to compromise herself or her beliefs. She also refuses to give up on herself. As a person who has suffered from a serious illness (that I was not expected to survive), I completely relate to the feeling sometimes of wanting to just give up. Of being so tired of fighting just to move through a common day. Of struggling with the most simplistic and mundane of tasks, and feeling that life is a little less vibrant because of all of it. So Evette spoke to me on a very fundamental level, and I found myself cheering for her courage and creativity in continuing to find happiness despite all she faced. And when she was wounded, I felt wounded. Only the very best characters are able to crawl into a reader's skin like this.

I feel that Evette is relatable across ages and experiences. Countless people have been criticized for their personal decisions by others, for a breathtaking array of reasons. But it all comes down to the same truth: other people somehow feel they have a right to "decide" what is the best course of action to deal with something they have never experienced themselves and (often) have actually never even heard about or studied. I suppose this knowledge simply comes to them from the cosmos? It astounds me that the same people who can get up in arms that you not "knock" a food "until you try it" will also insist that they know the very best way to deal with another person's life-altering situation without any experience or training whatsoever. But I digress.

Although Valen is the starring dragon shifter here, I wholeheartedly believe that Evette is the true heart of this story. She is the core, the true hero, and I absolutely adore her.

This entire story is an excellent example of the joy and unexpected benefits of thinking outside the box. Of refusing to be confined to societal expectations simply because "that's the way it's been done." In living her life true to herself, Evette brings such sunshine and joy and comfort to so many others. She is my hero.
