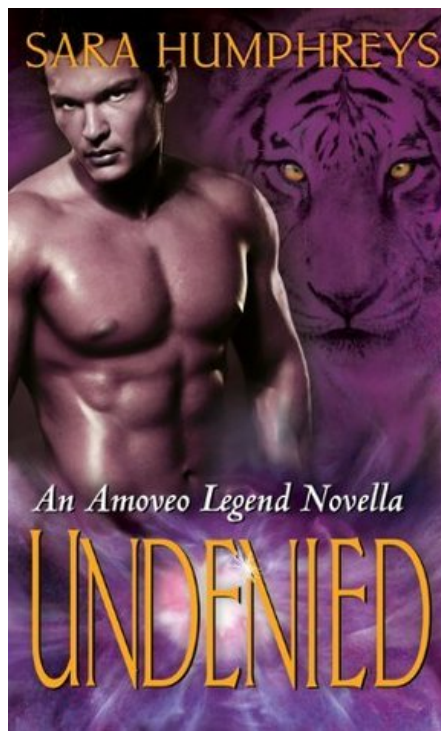

My first delve into Sara Humphreys, and I am afraid I might just be hooked.

Although this is a very short novella (only about 25 pages), I think it is a GREAT way to find out if Sara's novels might be something you would be interested in. It shows the humor that I am sure is riddled throughout her novels, it gives you a glimpse of the action that can only happen when there are ten different shape shifting clans, and it give you taste of what are sure to be steamy scenes in her novels. (Yes, she got all that in with just 25 pages!)

And hell, this one has a man that shape shifts into a tiger...
Sign me up.

The story may flow better if you've read the first three full length novels, I don't know, I haven't read them yet. I can honestly say though that I was not confused about anything. In 25 pages Sara explained her world brilliantly, made me laugh, made me blush, and made me root for the hero in a quick battle. I've always held that an author that can stir emotions in a (very) short story may just be better than one that does it in a full length novel.

2.5 stars (an extra half star for promise) There are the pieces of a really good story in this short entry in Humphrey's Amoveo series, but this needed to be just a bit longer to really take advantage of the setup: A wandering psychic who reads palms to earn a living follows her dreams to New Orleans and ends up in the path of Tiger shifter Boris and in the middle of a war in which the shape-shifting Amoveo are drawing battle lines against mating with half breeds.

I haven't read the other books in the series yet (they are still in my pile) so it may well be that fans will bring enough of the framework of the series - and maybe knowledge of Boris - and will be happy with this little quickie of a story, but even though I got this as a Kindle freebie I just needed 'more' to make the romance work for me.

Sara Humphreys has created an interesting new world of shifters. Since this story, Undenied, is free, it could be a good introductory book for you. If you like it, then read the rest in order, #1 Unleashed, #2 Untouched, #3 Untamed, #4 Undone and finally #5 Unclaimed. Start of new series Amoveo Rising (Undiscovered) is coming out March, 2017.

Very short novella, I would recommend reading the first two books in the series before starting this one.

Lillian is a palm reading, hippy human who dreams of Tigers. When her dream tiger told her to come to New Orleans she didn't question it. Upon her arrival she was told that the place she had rented for the next six months was no longer vacant, and that it had been rented to someone else. All alone in a big city, facing more time sleeping in her van she walks to the only other place that may have a vacancy. The Den is a bar with a few rooms for rent. Boris owns the bar, and is a from the tiger clan, he realizes immediately that Lillian is his mate. Hayden is the son of the leader of the bear clan. He is one of the purists intent on ridding their race of humans and hybrids. He catches Boris and Lillian kissing and declares that he will kill Boris and fuck Lillian. The two fight, but Hayden is forced to disappear to prevent Boris from killing him. Boris tells Lillian that they will always be in danger from the other purists, but she tells him that she has finally found home and doesn't want to run.

2 1/2 to 3 stars

This was a super quick novella with some interesting moments and definite potential, but the storyline and love relationship developed way too fast for this reader to find believable.

This tale needed more time and fleshing out to give us a sense of what these two would come to mean to one another and also for me to buy into the connection.

It was too much *tell* and not enough *show*.

Lillian (a homeless palm reader) and Boris (a tiger shifter/bar owner/potential landlord) are destined mates. When they meet, they feel a connection to one another because of dreams they've had over the years that have forged a unique bond between them.

The next thing we know, they're kissing, getting intimate pretty damn quick, suddenly fighting for their lives, and then knocking the boots. After they have sex, Boris thinks to himself that he *loves her* because he's already met her in his dreams and feels he knows her.

Whoa, seriously slow down, shifter dude.

(That's *too* much insta in the insta love department for me.)

At one point, he does a mating ritual (by using a specific set of words) without explaining to Lillian what he's doing beforehand.

I would argue that it's kind of important to discuss these things with one's partner and mate, since it involves

them after all, but whatever. She's fine with how that all went down because he totally rocks in the sack (she does, in fact, call him a 'rock star') and she just wants to find out more.

And, at the end, when all is said and done on this incredibly quick journey to love and complete understanding, they acknowledge that they must face an uncertain future together... for reasons... and that they've totally got each other's backs.

(I think this all took place in the span of one day/evening, but I'm not sure. I might have missed something...)
