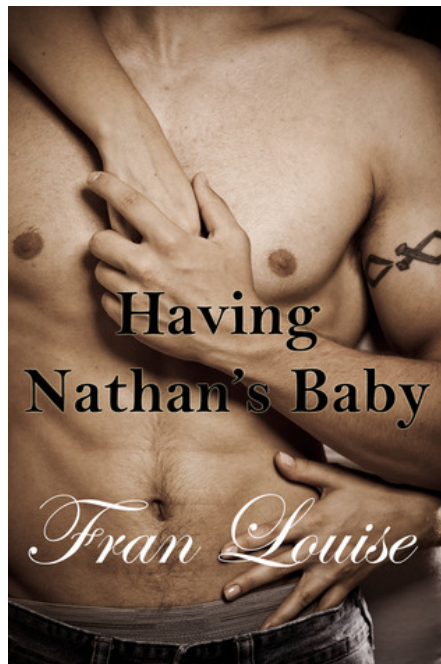




Having Nathan's Baby
