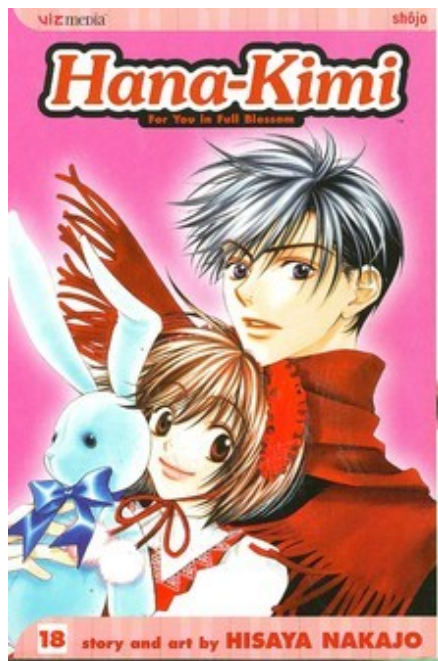




Hana-Kimi: For You in Full Blossom, Vol. 18
