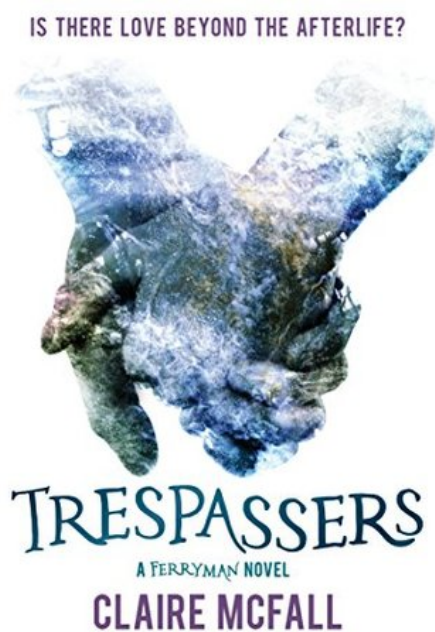

Although the book mentions the weirdness of Tristan's situation and sudden appearance in the real world, it doesn't bother too much with explaining how it's been navigated which isn't a bad thing as the story concentrates on the aftermath and results of what the pair have achieved and what has followed them. I liked the new characters introduced in this second title (even the unlikable one) and felt they really added something to the story as I was waiting to see what direction it took with them now in it.
